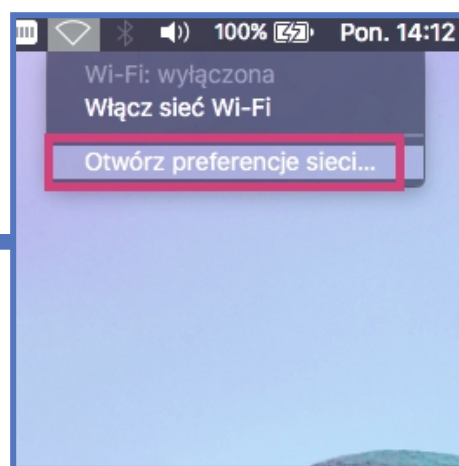


## Removing eduroam profile - Apple OS X

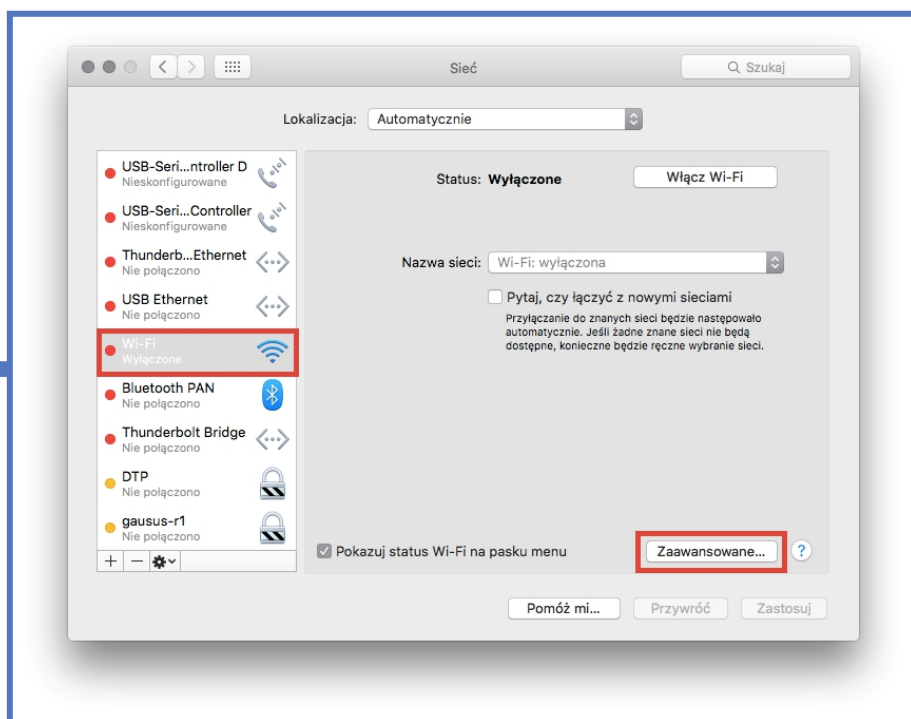
**Eduroam** (Edu-cation roam-ing) is a world-wide project to provide wireless access to students, researchers and university staff. These users have wireless internet access in all participating organisations, without the need to reconfigure their devices.

### Step by step guide

1. Click on the network icon in the taskbar
2. In the newly opened list, select the "Open network preferences"



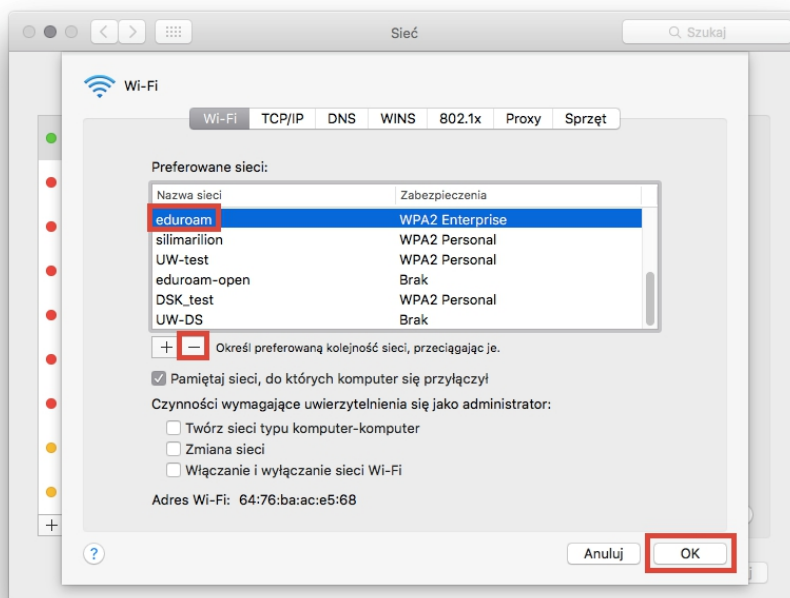
3. In the network preferences panel, select the Wi-Fi tab and click the "Advanced" button



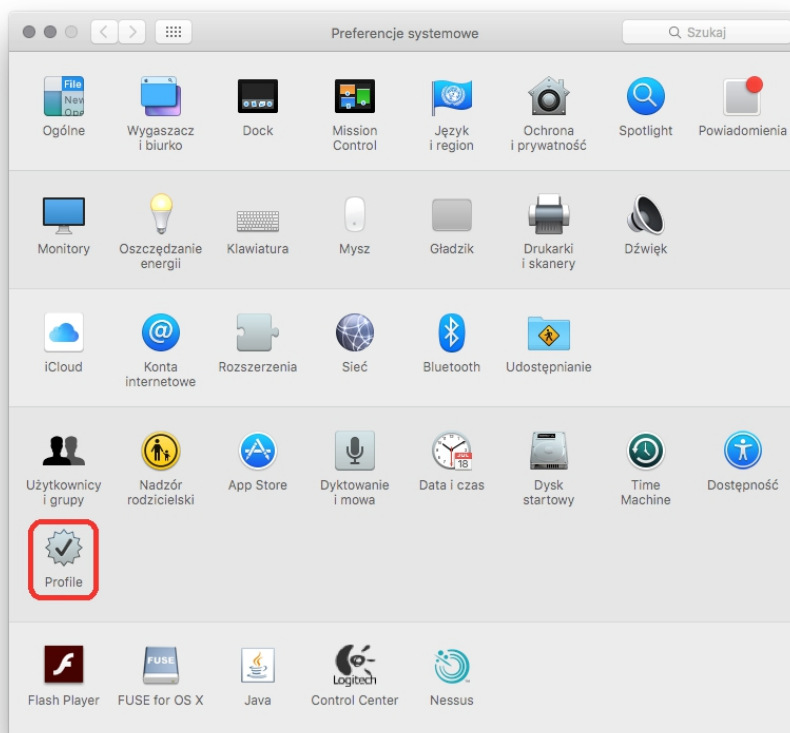

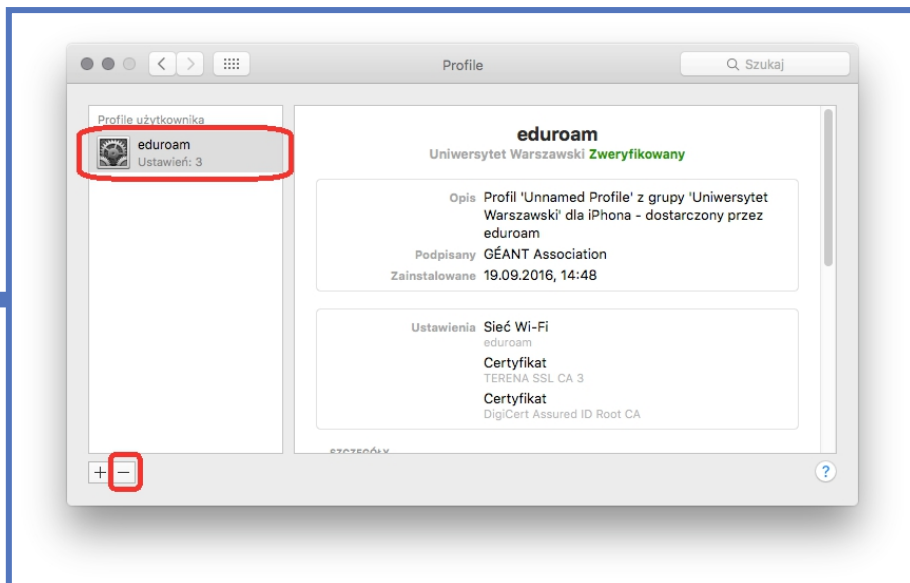
4. Select the eduroam network profile and delete it from the list using the “-”
5. Confirmed changes by clicking the “OK” button



6. Those who have had an 802.1x profile installed by the eduroam installer must also follow the steps below
7. Enter “System Preferences” and select “Profiles”



8. Select the eduroam profile and delete it from the list with the "-" button



9. Confirm the deletion of the profile
